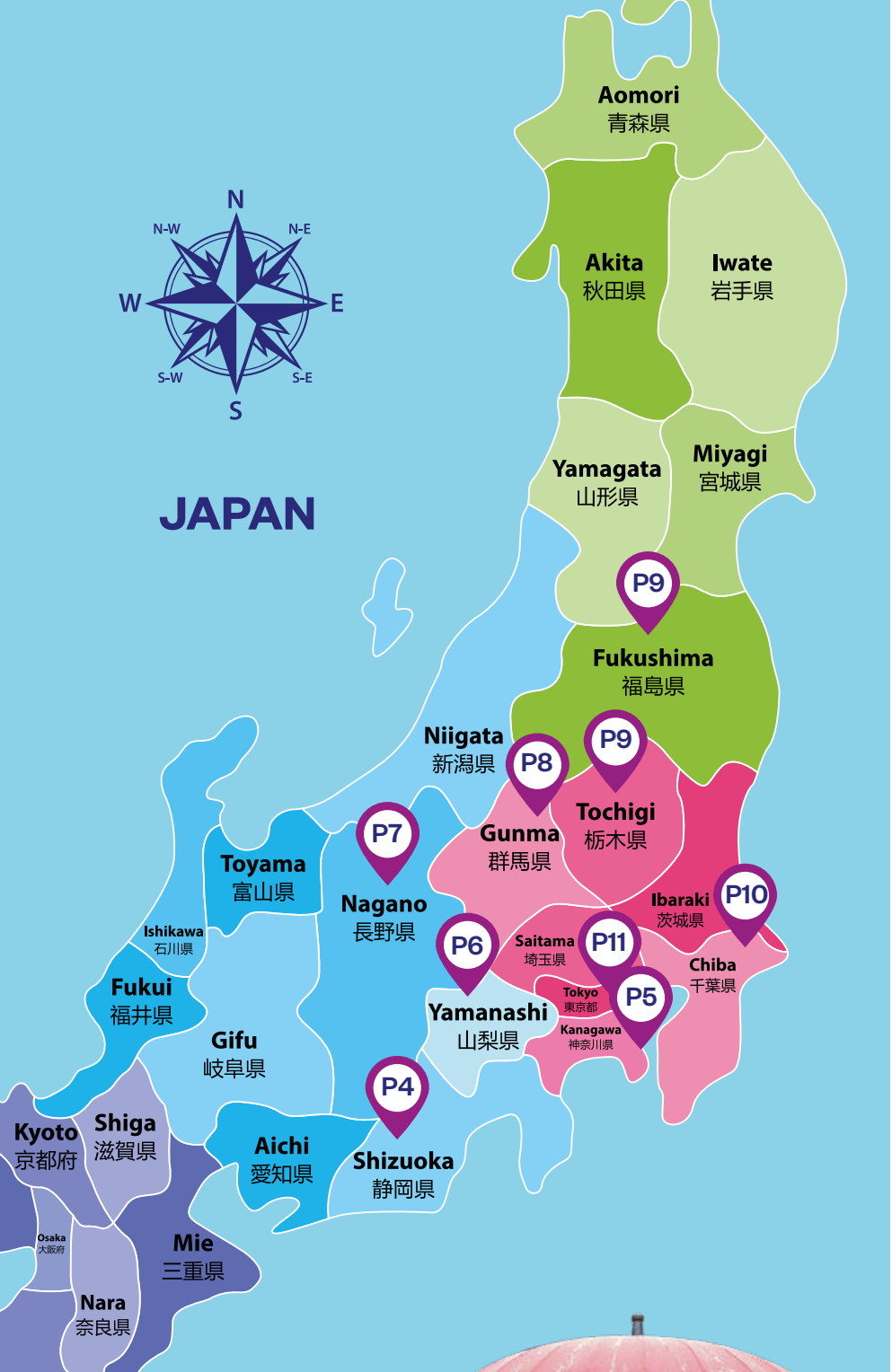

I hope you find the first edition of *Club Wyndham* magazine both inspiring and informative. We look forward to welcoming you to one of your new club resorts soon!

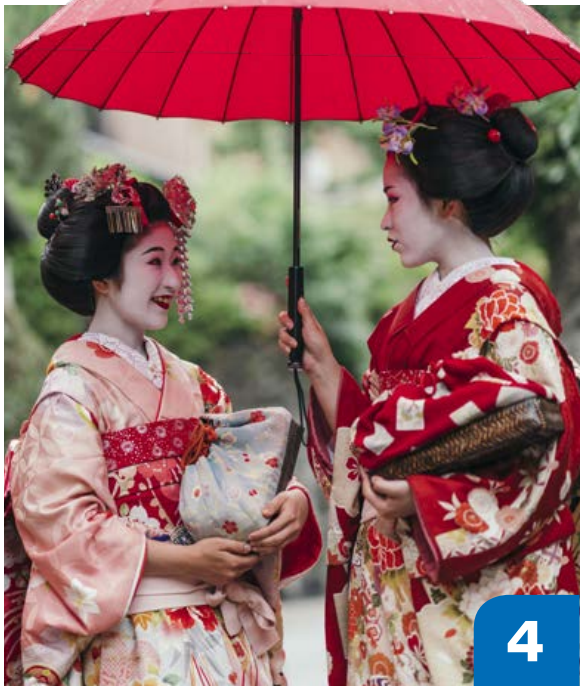

# CLUB WYNDHAM

In the coming pages, we profile your 16 new resorts and the incredible experiences they open up for you. We also look at significant expansions underway at two Club Wyndham favourites: Ramada by Wyndham Phillip Island and Club Wyndham Flynn's Beach.

## Shizuoka Prefecture

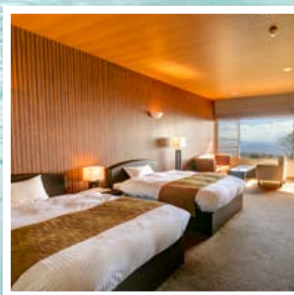
The Izu Peninsula is a well-known resort precinct and is famous for its onsens (hot springs). Atami in particular is renowned for hot spring resorts and even free footbaths, like the one near Atami Station. The onsens here are rich in sulfates and salts, and one shogun (military leader) in the 16th century was rumoured to have carted the water from here back to Tokyo!

The closest hotspots to Izu-Kogen are Amagi in the centre of the peninsula and the city of Ito, both within half an hour's drive. It has the hottest water in the Shizuoka prefecture.

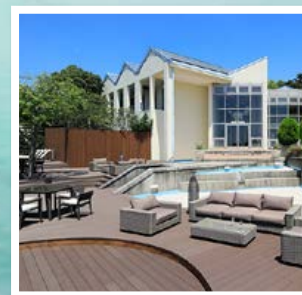
Other attractions worth visiting include the Jogasaki Coast's suspension bridge, the seven waterfalls at Kawazu Nanadaru and the Kawazu Cherry Festival in February.



Situated in the coastal city of Atami on the Sagami Bay, CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT ATAMI is a small resort within walking distance of Kinomiya Station. The resort features an onsite lounge, children's room, games room and offers complimentary Wi-Fi in public places. Some apartments have Western-style bedding; three have a Western-style bathroom.



CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT IZU-KOGEN sits just minutes from Japan's southern coast and offers a children's room, barbecue area, sauna, games room, onsite lounge and restaurant offering breakfast and dinner. Apartments are one or two-bedroom, and most have Japanese-style bedding, while four have a Western-style bathroom.



The nearby CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT SUNDANCE IZU-KOGEN ANNEX features a children's room, onsite lounge, games room and onsite restaurant offering breakfast and dinner. Half of the apartments have Western-style beds; none have a bathroom.

# Land of the Rising Sun

*Thanks to its rich culture, friendly people and diverse experiences on offer, Japan is one of the most popular tourist destinations on the planet.*

*Fifteen Japanese properties are now available to Club Wyndham South Pacific owners. The 16th resort - in Naeba, a ski destination - is undergoing refurbishment and will be introduced to the club at a later date. In the following pages, we will take a closer look at each of the resorts available to you now and some of the nation's must-see attractions.*

## Kanagawa Prefecture

Both resorts in the Kanagawa prefecture are in the heart of the charming old precinct of Hakone near Lake Ashinoko, a volcanic crater offering incredible views of the nearby Mount Fuji. Tour boats designed to look like warships from the Edo era of the early 1600s to the mid-1800s cruise the giant inland lake.

On Lake Ashinoko's shores is one of the region's drawcards, Hakone Shrine. The path to the shrine is lined with orange lanterns and the mist that seems to perpetually sit

in the surrounding forest adds an element of mystery to the religious building. Also nearby is the Old Tokaido Road, the remains of the first well-policed road connecting Tokyo with Kyoto in the Edo-era, and an open air museum with over a thousand sculptures.

Explore Owakudani, a crater rich in sulphur vents and hot springs, which was created when Mount Hakone last erupted. Locals cook eggs in these springs and they turn a black colour – they claim these can lengthen your life! Check beforehand whether Owakudani is open: it can sometimes be restricted because of the chance of eruption.

## BUCKET LIST SUGGESTION

Visit the mysterious **HAKONE SHRINE**. Consider a day trip to Kamakura to visit religious landmarks, including the famous 93-tonne Buddha, which is almost 800 years old, as well as Kenchoji temple, Engakuji temple and Hasedera temple.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT HAKONE-GORA** is positioned in the heart of the Fuji-hakone-izu National Park. The resort includes a children's room, gift shop and complimentary Wi-Fi. Most apartments have Japanese-style bedding and two have a Western-style bathroom.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT HAKONE-MIYAGINO** features a tennis court, children's room, barbecue area, onsite lounge, gift shop and a restaurant open for breakfast and dinner. The resort has a variety of apartment types, which can accommodate up to eight people. Half of the apartments have Western-style bedding. This resort has traditional Japanese shared bathroom facilities. If driving there in winter, we recommend using snow chains or studless snow tyres.







# YAMANASHI PREFECTURE

*The most famous drawcard of the Yamanashi prefecture is Japan's highest volcano, Mount Fuji. The symmetrical cone has a snow-capped peak five months of the year and was named a World Heritage Site in 2013.*

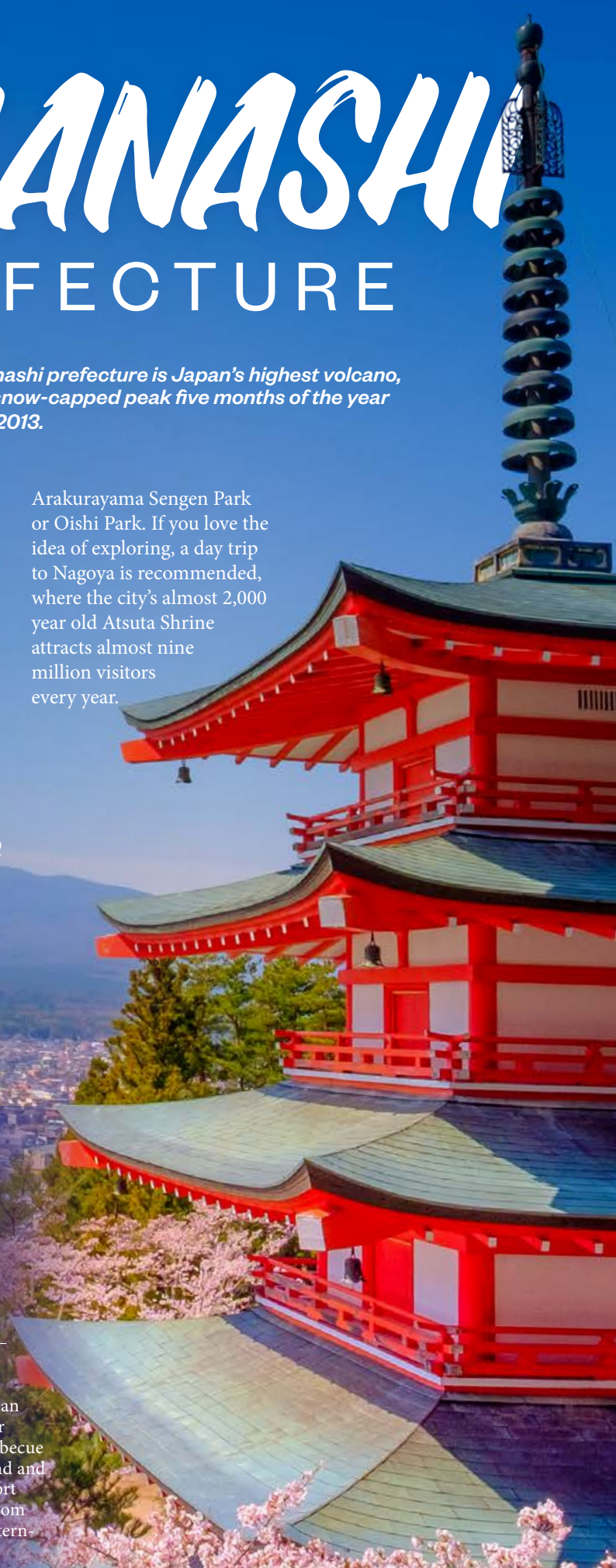
The best time to climb Mount Fuji is between July and August when the weather is the warmest – even if it only hits a high of around seven to 10 degrees Celsius on average! During these months, huts along the trails are open and buses are running. Climbing between October and May is not recommended, because of the tundra climate the upper reaches of the mountain has.

There are four routes up the summit; the Yoshida route is the closest to Club Wyndham Sundance Resort

Kawaguchiko, while the Subashiri route is nearest to Club Wyndham Sundance Resort Yamanakako. The former route is the most popular because there are several mountain huts along the way to stop, while the latter is one of the most popular descents.

If you like to get your adrenaline pumping, set some time aside to try thrilling rollercoasters at nearby Fuji-Q Highland – or, if you prefer peace and quiet, arrange a trip to Lake Kawaguchi,

Arakurayama Sengen Park or Oishi Park. If you love the idea of exploring, a day trip to Nagoya is recommended, where the city's almost 2,000 year old Atsuta Shrine attracts almost nine million visitors every year.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT KAWAGUCHIKO** offers complimentary Wi-Fi, a children's playground, barbecue area and sauna. Five apartments have Western-style beds, while all have a Western-style bathroom.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT YAMANAKAKO** boasts an onsite restaurant open for breakfast and dinner, barbecue area, children's playground and free bike rentals. The resort offers one and two-bedroom apartments, all with Western-style bathroom and beds.



# Nagano

## P R E F E C T U R E

The mountainous Nagano Prefecture is home to nine of the highest 12 peaks in Japan and is well-known for its snow resorts. The region famously held the 1998 Winter Olympics, with Karuizawa hosting some events.

The ski precinct of Hakuba is within a couple of hours of alpine travel from Karuizawa and offers 10 ski resorts, accessible through just the one lift pass. It has the steepest runs in Japan and boasts the most sunshine of the region's valleys.

Shirakaba 2 in 1 near Tateshina has seven lifts and 11 pistes,

best suited for beginner and intermediate skiers and snowboarders. The Shirakaba Highland International Ski Area is also nearby, but only for skiers.

However, summer also offers plenty to get the heart racing. The picturesque terrain at the giant Chubu Sangaku National Park makes for a pleasant hike or bike ride and the incredible vistas at the park's Kamikochi and the Kurumayama Highland are renowned. Train lines run through the mountainous region and can simplify your trip.

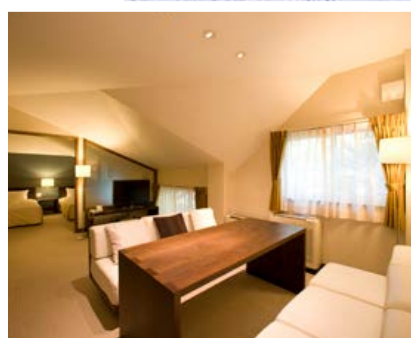
Make sure you also see Mt Asama Magma Stone Park – a countryside of stone monuments and columns created when the volcano last erupted in 1783.



Situated in picturesque forest, **CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT TATESHINA** is a spacious property boasting a tennis court (closed in winter), children's room, barbecue area, sauna and a restaurant for breakfast and dinner. Most apartments have Western-style bedding; however, most do not have a Western-style bathroom.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT KARUIZAWA** boasts an onsite restaurant open for breakfast and dinner, complimentary Wi-Fi and bike rentals (unavailable during winter). All apartments have Western-style bedding and Western-style bathroom.





# Gunma PREFECTURE

The Kusatsu region of the Gunma Prefecture enjoys hot summers and cold winters – it gets up to an average of 30 degrees Celsius in the summer and down to an average of -14 degrees Celsius in the winter.

Kusatsu is well known for its onsen – in fact, Japan’s travel agents believe it has the best. The waters are famous for their healing qualities, so it’s no surprise that bygone warlords used to have the water taken to old Tokyo.

There are also plenty of thermal wonders: nearby Mt Kusatsu-Shirane is an active volcano with crater lakes, including Yugama, the most acidic lake in Japan.

Summer is an ideal time to hike the mountain, although it can be done in winter with snowshoes. The prefecture is also known for its winter pursuits: you can try some of these at the Kusatsu Kokusai Ski Resort, where you can ski, snowboard and even heli-ski.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT KUSATSU** offers complimentary Wi-Fi, an indoor heated pool, tennis court, gym, sauna and the option of breakfast and dinner served in your apartment. No rooms have Western-style bedding, but all have a Western-style bathroom.

# Fukushima

## PREFECTURE

The region of Urabandai, in the south of the Fukushima prefecture, is a delight for avid explorers and amateur photographers all through the year. The colours of the dramatic mountains, valleys and lakes change with the seasons and travellers arrive for different experiences.

The region's variant topography is a legacy of volcanic eruptions and summer time provides an incredible opportunity to trial a variety of hiking trails. In winter, the surrounds become a snowscape and a range of ski resorts open for you to test your skills on the slopes. There are three courses locally and a child-care facility. If you are driving in winter, snow chains or studless snow tyres are recommended.

Beautiful in any season is the Goshikinuma (Five-Coloured Lakes) walking trail, which takes you to lakes in red, green and light blue hues – a legacy of the area's volcanic past.



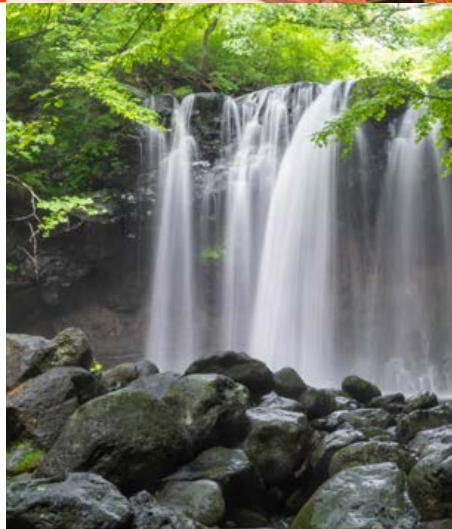
# TOCHIGI

## PREFECTURE

Nasu, in the north of the Tochigi prefecture, is a highland region presided over by Mount Nasu. The mountain offers incredible hiking trails and a range of suspension bridges at the lower regions, which make it simple to enjoy the glorious views.

The region produces dairy and is renowned for its variety of cheeses. Nasu Kogen Beer's use of brewing techniques from Germany has also made it a must-visit for lovers of craft beer.

During the winter, skiing and snowboarding aficionados can head to Hunter Mountain Shiobara on Mount Takahara and enjoy the slopes or warm themselves in one of the region's famous onsens.



**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE LAKE RESORT** boasts a suite of features, including complimentary Wi-Fi, a gift shop, sauna, games room and children's room. It has two bars, *Playspot* and *Scat*, and three restaurants: buffet restaurant *Hibara* open for breakfast and dinner, Japanese restaurant *Waraku* open for lunch and dinner, and French restaurant *Maple* open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. All rooms have Western-style beds and ensuites.

# Chiba

## PREFECTURE

The Chiba prefecture's eastern coast is famous for its laidback, eclectic surfer-town feel. The area's free of giant buildings, with local shops serving up the day's catch and beachside restaurants cooking with local ingredients.

People flock to the coast for kiteboarding, stand-up paddle boarding and surfing. Katsuura and Onjuku are both highly-rated spots with warm waters and plenty of room. Up the road, Ichinomiya has been selected to host the first ever Olympic surfing competition in 2020.



With a prime location right on the beach at Ajiro Bay, **CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT ONJUKU** boasts a children's playground, barbecue area and room service for breakfast or dinner. Most apartments have Western-style bedding and all have a Western-style bathroom.

**CLUB WYNDHAM SUNDANCE RESORT KATSUURA EAST** offers complimentary Wi-Fi, an outdoor pool (available in summer), a tennis court, conference facilities, sauna and onsite restaurant *Ai*, which is open for breakfast and dinner, as well as lunch during summer school holidays, New Year and Golden Week (first week of May). *Tokyo is Japan's capital and one of the largest cities in the world with 38 million people in its greater region. Its start as a humble fishing village before being fortified in the 12th century is a far cry from the giant metropolis it has become.*

The city is bursting with things to do and see. If you love technology, a visit to Akihabara will give you the chance to pore over the latest gadgets – and find out more about anime culture. If you are craving Japanese food, the city has 234 Michelin-starred restaurants, the most of any city. Harajuku and Shibuya are fashion precincts and a must-visit for avid shoppers.

Take a step back into Tokyo's proud history by visiting the famous Sensoji temple, the Imperial Palace and Tokyo

Station, or take in some of the famous modern-day landmarks like Tokyo Tower or Tokyo Skytree, the world's second-tallest tower.

Tokyo is worthy of a day trip no matter which club resort you are visiting. If you have a family, you may want to schedule a special day just for Tokyo Disneyland and its seven themed areas. More than 18 million families visited last year, which made it the third-most visited theme park in the world.

The resort is about 35 kilometres to the significant regional city of Rouen, which dates back to the 3rd century. The present capital of Normandy, it previously served as the royal seat when Normandy was a kingdom, before William the Conqueror – who conquered England – moved it to nearby Caen.

Rouen is famous as the place where freedom fighter Joan of Arc was brought to trial, an incident remembered through the Church of St Joan of Arc at the centre of the Place du Vieux Marché.

Other sights to see in the city include the majestic Rouen Cathedral, Rouen Castle and the Palais de Justice, once the seat of law in Normandy, while the nation's capital, Paris, is under an hour away by car.

Paris is considered one of the most romantic cities, with wedding planning site Hitched finding that the French capital is home to the world's top proposal site: Disneyland Paris. The iconic Eiffel Tower, rated number four for proposals, is considered one of the world's most recognised landmarks.

The city is also an epicentre for European art. The famed Louvre attracted 10.2 million visitors last year, making it the most visited art museum in the world. Musée d'Orsay, Musée de l'Orangerie and Musée National d'Art Moderne all have noted historical art collections and are worthy of a visit. The

city is teeming with landmarks detailing all points in Parisian history, and the district along the River Seine in the city centre is a UNESCO Heritage Site.

The region also holds historical significance for Australia and New Zealand. The Western Front during World War I went through Normandy and a number of significant battle sites, including Fromelles, are a few hours' drive from the resort. There are more than 10 memorial sites for fallen Anzacs, the closet at Vignacourt, Villers-Bretonneux and Le Hamel, which are within two hours' drive. The Australian Remembrance Trail highlights the best sites to pay tribute to the fallen.

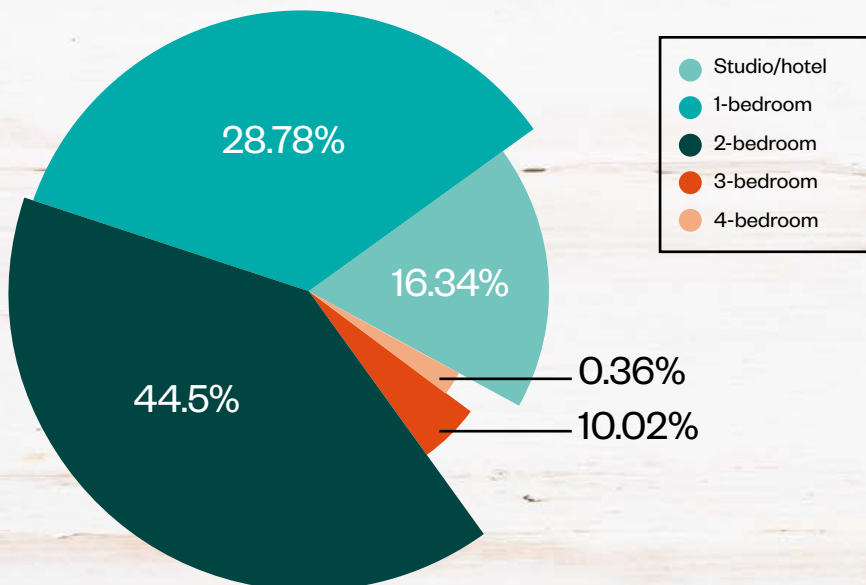

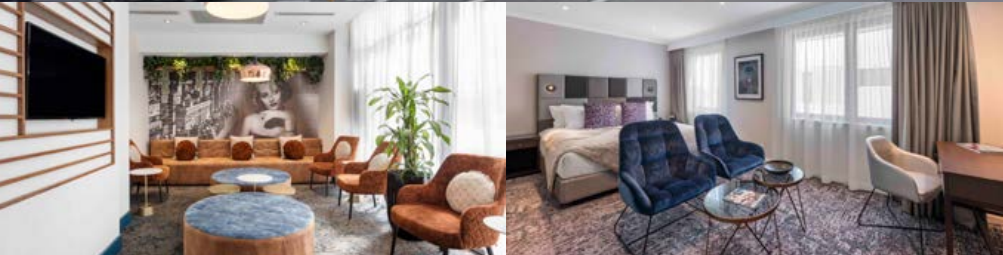
## CLUB WYNDHAM SYDNEY

*A major refurbishment of all 120 apartments at Club Wyndham Sydney concluded in September. All rooms and internal corridors were decorated with new furniture, artwork and soft furnishings during the five-month project, which was completed in 13 stages.*

Each room type also features a different design and colour scheme.

Your club hotel looks different from the outside, too. Club Wyndham Sydney will soon be adorned with one of the nation's largest murals, which aims to celebrate the personality and history of this part of Australia's largest city. Given its prominent position on the corner of Wentworth Avenue and Goulburn Street, the mural is expected to become a city landmark.

The 14-storey artwork is inspired by the 1940s and depicts a man's face and a woman with a vintage home movie camera, a tribute to the city's arts and cinema community.



## RAMADA BY WYNDHAM PHILLIP ISLAND

All 54 rooms at Ramada Phillip Island that were part of the club prior to 2019 will undergo a major refurbishment from March 2020. For more details on this, see page 18.

## CLUB WYNDHAM PORT DOUGLAS

The 87 Club Wyndham South Pacific rooms at Club Wyndham Port Douglas will undergo a minor refurbishment, starting in April 2020.

The project will incorporate new furniture, artwork, soft furnishings and window and floor coverings. The rooms

will feature relaxing colour schemes, which are inspired by the region's tropical weather and natural wonders, including the Great Barrier Reef and Daintree Rainforest.

The refurbishment will be conducted in 10 stages and is slated to conclude in June 2020.

## CLUB WYNDHAM BALLARAT

Club Wyndham Ballarat's 39 apartments are undergoing a major refurbishment, which began in October.

All bathrooms will be fully renovated, with new floor coverings laid in all rooms. Window coverings, lighting, soft furnishings, beds and some furniture will be replaced.

Apartments will be repainted in two different design and colour schemes for standard and Deluxe apartments, which all aim to enhance the historic value of the property.

The project will be conducted in five stages and is expected to be completed in late December this year.

## CLUB WYNDHAM DENARAU ISLAND

One of your favourite club properties is scheduled for refurbishment in 2020! This project will take in 61 Deluxe, Grand and Presidential apartments.

It will include new paint finishes and colour schemes designed to enhance natural light, updated bedding and outdoor furniture, a refresh of apartment furniture and fresh soft furnishings, rugs and window coverings.

The new designs for your club apartments are inspired by the tropical surrounds of Denarau Island and the Pacific Ocean on the resort's doorstep. To minimise effects to availability, rooms will be renovated in nine stages with just four to nine apartments undergoing refurbishment at any time.

The project is expected to start in February 2020 and is scheduled to finish in April 2020.

## WYNDHAM DESTINATIONS LAUNCHES GLOBAL SUSTAINABILITY STRATEGY

Wyndham Destinations, the parent company of Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific – which manages Club Wyndham South Pacific – has launched its global sustainability strategy, called **Full Circle**.

Your club destinations are in some of the most pristine locations in the South Pacific and South East Asia and, as part of Full Circle, Wyndham Destinations has set measurable goals and targets to support the communities in which it operates.

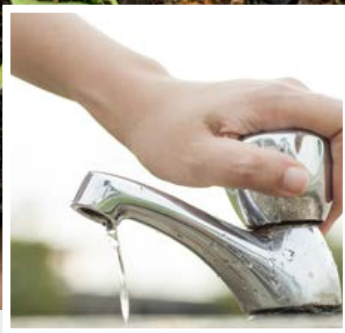
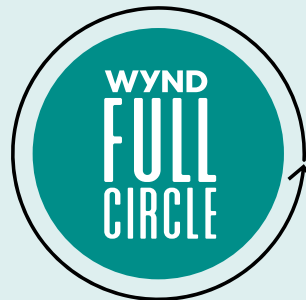
### STRAW BAN ACROSS NUMEROUS CLUB PROPERTIES

Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific has rolled out a ban on disposable plastic straws at 37 properties across the Asia Pacific region.

Fully implemented as of July 2019, the ban is expected to eliminate the use of more than 400,000 plastic straws every year. Single-use plastic straws are generally only used for about 15 minutes, never fully decompose and are one of the top ten items found in beach clean-ups globally.

Instead of plastic straws, properties will offer paper straws on request. The move is designed to reduce plastic consumption and follows a switch to plant-based biodegradable packaging and compostable cutlery.

The majority of club properties will enforce the ban. Properties managed on a contractual basis for Club Wyndham South Pacific will continue to operate using policies implemented by the respective property manager.



### REHOMED FURNITURE GETS SECOND LEASE ON LIFE

**Thousands of pieces of quality used furniture from Club Wyndham South Pacific refurbishments are now finding worthy homes, thanks to an initiative of the Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific Property Development team.**

Every year, the team renovates hundreds of club rooms with thousands of pieces of furniture and, regrettably, landfill often ends up being an economical solution. However, the team is now partnering with charities that take the furniture and provide it to

people who need it.

Local charity **The Generous and The Grateful** received six tonnes of furniture from the recent Club Wyndham Sydney refurbishment and has been able to give the vast majority to vulnerable people who have shelter but no furniture.

In 2019, the property development team has so far supplied 238 beds, 160 dining tables, 382 bedside tables and 611 chairs to a series of community partners.

## THE SIGNIFICANCE OF CLUB LEVIES

### The Value of Timeshare Ownership with Club Wyndham

Many of the expenses associated with owning a holiday apartment, unit or townhouse in Australia or New Zealand need to be paid regardless of how often you use it.

Ownership usually means being part of a body corporate, which handles the management and upkeep of the building and grounds. Body corporates are responsible for common areas and may pay for the upkeep of facilities like pools, gyms, tennis courts and, in some cases, concierge or a building manager. In Australia, for a good condition waterfront holiday apartment with a pool and resort style facilities, unit owners can expect to pay in the vicinity of AU\$5,000 to AU\$8,000 per annum, or around \$100 to \$150 per week.

Councils also charge rates, generally on a half-yearly basis. In many areas, water and sewerage is charged separately every three months and a significant portion of that is an infrastructure charge that exists regardless of usage. Together, they can amount to thousands of dollars a year. Then home insurance needs to be factored in as well as utilities such as electricity and gas.

If a property is regularly used for a few years, the property may need refurbishment and this can amount to tens of thousands of dollars.

### Where do my levies go?

By comparison, timeshare owners in Club Wyndham South Pacific pay only in

proportion to the scale of their ownership in the club.

All levies received are applied toward the operation of your club and the maintenance of your club properties. A portion of your levies go toward fulfilling the body corporate function of a resort including a reserve account used to maintain common areas as necessary as well as apartment refurbishments and replacement of fixtures and fittings.

The Property Development and Resort Operations team is responsible for keeping all club resorts in the excellent condition that you have come to expect. This group oversees projects from major changes like exterior painting or carpet replacement to more subtle updates, such as new bedspreads or unit lighting improvements, and everything in between. Owner feedback is taken into consideration and painstaking efforts are made to ensure that each dollar is spent wisely while keeping your resorts in 'like new' condition.

The largest portion of your levies goes to resort operating costs, including rates, water and sewerage charges, utilities, insurances, resort staff wages and management services. Your levies also fund your owner services support (e.g. reservations) and your Owner Information Centre – both important services to help you to use and enjoy your club ownership.

## MUCH-LOVED RESORT INDUCTED INTO HALL OF FAME

One of Fiji's most highly rated resorts, **Club Wyndham Denarau Island**, has been inducted into the **TripAdvisor Certificate of Excellence Hall of Fame**.

The Certificate of Excellence is awarded to accommodation, restaurants and attractions on TripAdvisor that consistently achieve high reviews and the Hall of Fame recognises those that have received the certificate for five years.

Club Wyndham Denarau Island has received consistently positive feedback from vacation owners for its spacious apartments, prime location and high standard of service.



## WYNDHAM WINS AT HOTEL AND TIMESHARE INDUSTRY AWARDS

Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific has been recognised with significant wins at both the recent **Hotel Management (HM) Awards** and the **Australian Timeshare and Holiday Ownership Council (ATHOC) Awards**.

In the annual HM Awards, Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific was honoured with both the **Best Environmental Program** accolade for the initiatives rolled out by its **Wyndham Green** committee and the **Service to the Community** award for the work done by its philanthropic program, **Wishes by Wyndham**.

Since 2009, staff have raised more than **AU\$400,000** through Wishes – including **AU\$56,814** last year – for a number of charities focused on supporting children and their families.
