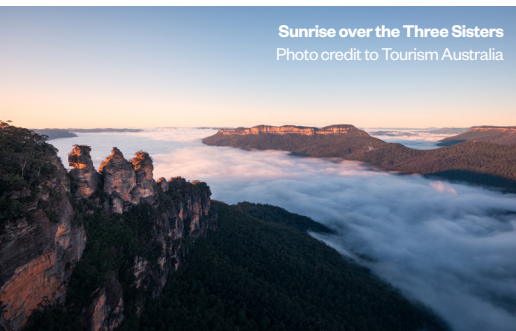
Hunter Valley

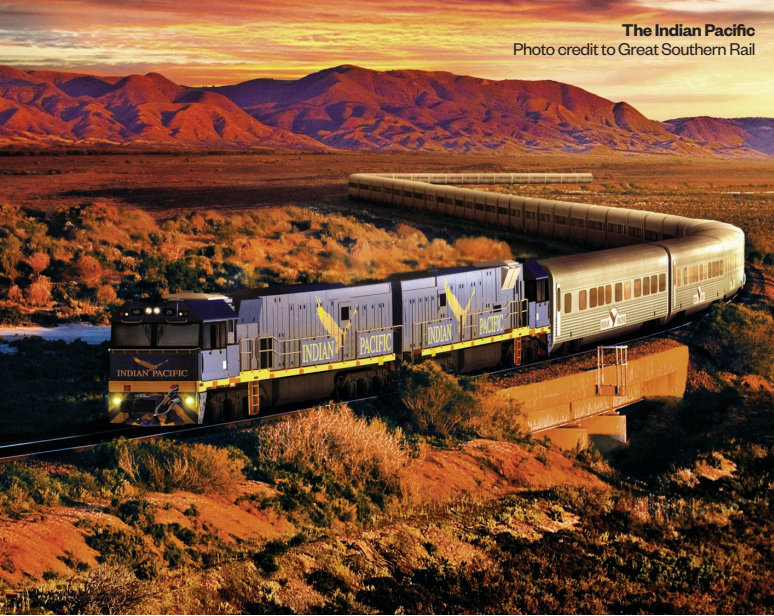

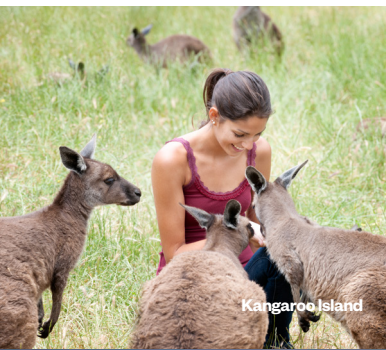
McClaren Vale and Barossa Valleys

Monkey Mia Reserve and Ningaloo Reef

Renowned the world over for its dolphins who have an almost daily ritual of visiting humans on the sea shore, Monkey Mia Reserve is one of those bucket list destinations that is a worthwhile pilgrimage to make.

Every bit as beautiful as Queensland's Great Barrier Reef, Ningaloo Reef is a World Heritage-listed Marine Park half way up the West Australian coastline. Its crystal clear waters are home to the world's largest fringing reef, which is teeming with turtles, tropical fish, manta rays, humpback whales and the elusive whale shark. Nowhere else on Earth do the gentle whale sharks reliably congregate in such large numbers as they do at Ningaloo Reef. While the marine playground is a huge drawcard, there are plenty of land adventures on offer too, from quad biking over sand dunes to kayaking through limestone gorges.

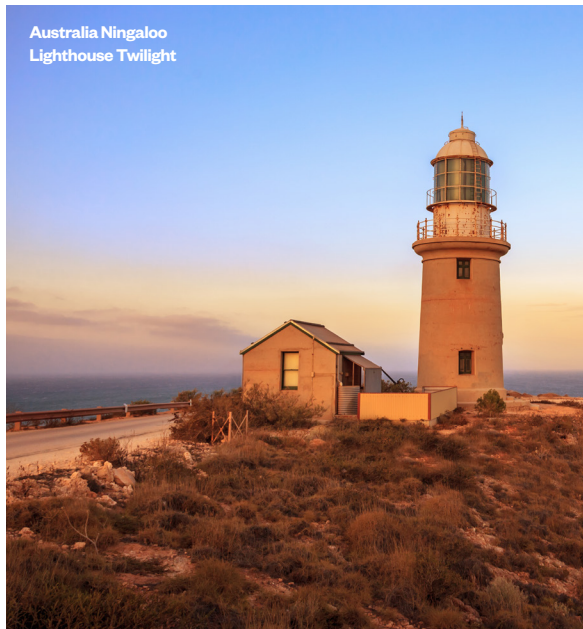

Now, our son has purchased his own ownership, so he can do the same with his extended family. The best thing is being able to share your holidays with loved ones." - Margit

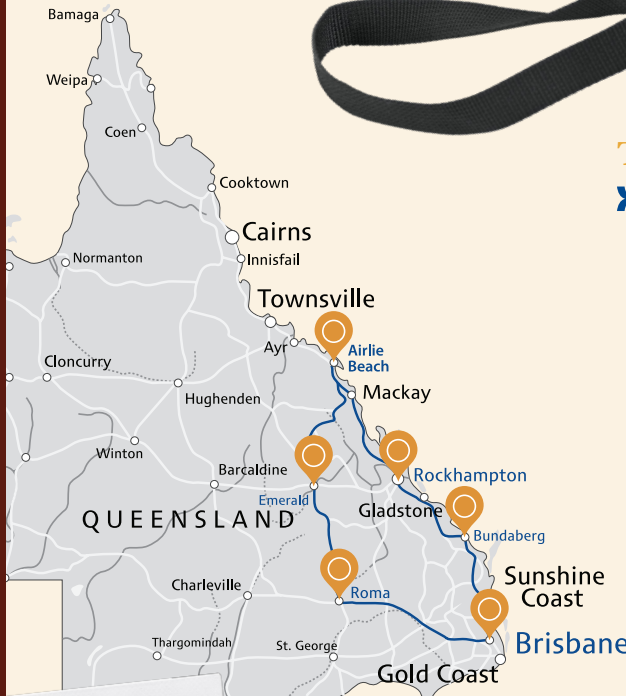

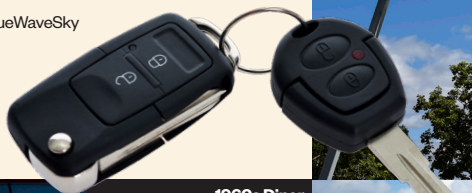

Ideal Spots for a Barbecue

» Club Wyndham Dunsborough

Club Wyndham Dunsborough offers three barbecue areas, each with great locations. The one near Toby's Inlet offers outstanding views, the second is positioned in the shade near the playground and is perfect for families, while the third is right near the outdoor fireplace and makes a winter's night comfortable.

The quality of the produce available in the Margaret River region ensures there is never a shortage of seasonal goods packed with flavour and absolute freshness able to be purchased nearby.

Dunsborough Butchering Co. is quite accessible from the resort - a 10-minute drive - and it offers free range chicken, beef, pork and lamb. It also provides organic grass-fed beef, lamb and chicken for customers interested in a more sustainable process. Another close option is **Amelia Park**, which sources product from a handful of the best lamb and beef farmers in their area, all of whom have a strict feeding regime to ensure they produce very clean meat.

For something a little different, the region offers venison - deer meat - at **Margaret River Venison Farm**. The business stocks a large range of Australian game meats direct from their farm shop which also showcases a range of local gourmet products sourced from Bunbury to Nannup. The farm is about half an hour from the resort.

Along with its local food, the Margaret River area is famous for producing a variety of wines. The **Cabernet Sauvignon** and **Semillon Sauvignon Blanc** varietals are particularly popular due to the local soils and the vineyards' closeness to the sea.

The local region is also home to many boutique breweries all selling takeaway options that go very well with any barbecue. Places such as **Eagle Bay Brewing Co** and **Wild Hop Brewing Company** are both within 15 minutes of the resort, while Busselton also features a new brewery right at the foreshore end of the jetty.

» Club Wyndham Pokolbin Hill

The barbecue facilities at Club Wyndham Pokolbin Hill, in New South Wales, are adjacent to the playground and pool, meaning you can keep an eye on your children or even enjoy the pool and leave a designated cook at the tools.

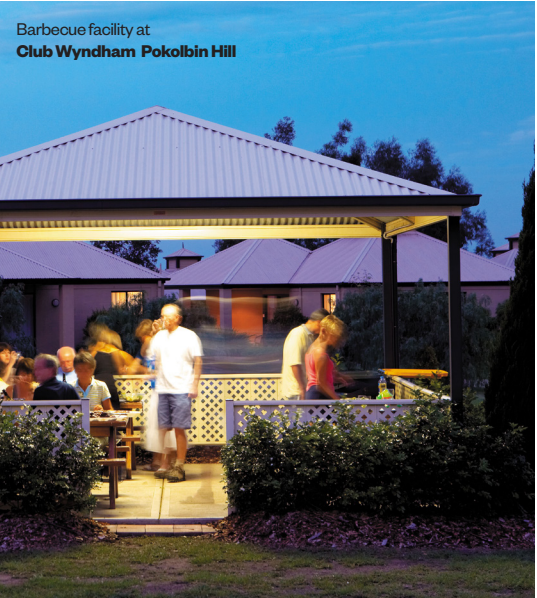
A good barbecue starts with quality meat and drink, and the Hunter Valley region is renowned for locally produced food and wine. **The Hungerford Meat Co.**, 15 kilometres away, has a deep and rich history embedded in the agriculture of the Hunter Valley. They produce all their own charcuterie and everything is free range. If you are looking for pasture-fed meat sourced locally in New South Wales,

The Pickled Pig Butchery nearby is also a good option.

If you need to make a quick run to get some more food, there's plenty of quality local produce less than 15 minutes away at **Wollombi Road Providore** - or there's the **Hunter Olive Centre**, which stocks products from local producers who don't have the scale for their own store.

A good drop will complete your feast. In the Hunter Valley, you are spoilt for choice but some top picks for a bottle of wine are: **Moorebank Vineyard**, **Gartelmann Wines** and **Brokenwood Wines**. They are all a few minutes' drive from the resort.

» Club Wyndham Seven Mile Beach

One of Australia's best-known tourist campaigns urged travellers to 'whack another shrimp on the barbie' and, in Tassie – well-known for its fresh seafood – you can do that.

You can get fresh oysters from **Barilla Bay Oysters**, one of Tasmania's leading suppliers of premium Pacific oysters, at its farm just the other side of the airport. It also offers prawn platters, fresh seafood and its own Worcestershire sauce (useful if you're making oysters Kilpatrick to go with your prawn skewers).

If you're looking for red meat, **Sorell Fine Meats** is a quick leap across the bay – a locally owned and operated butcher shop offering a wide variety of meats like chicken, beef, pork, duck, lamb and turkey. They are also open every day.

If you are happy to travel a little further afield, there are a plethora of options offering fresh meat and produce, including **TCM** at Lauderdale - a gourmet grocer for lovers of fine food. They offer high-quality locally sourced meat, fresh fruit and vegetables, a delicious deli range, grocery items and an in-store café. Meanwhile, **Hill Street Grocer** in Hobart specialises in the freshest locally grown fruit and vegetables, dairy, charcuterie, premium deli goods and scrumptious ready-to-eat meals, if you feel like doing a little less work. The shop even has a dedicated cheese room to showcase its enviable range.

Did You Know?

According to the Australian Food Timeline, backyard barbecues didn't take hold in the country until the early 1900s. It wasn't until the 1950s that the idea of a private BBQ in outdoor kitchens caught on, and we've never looked back.
