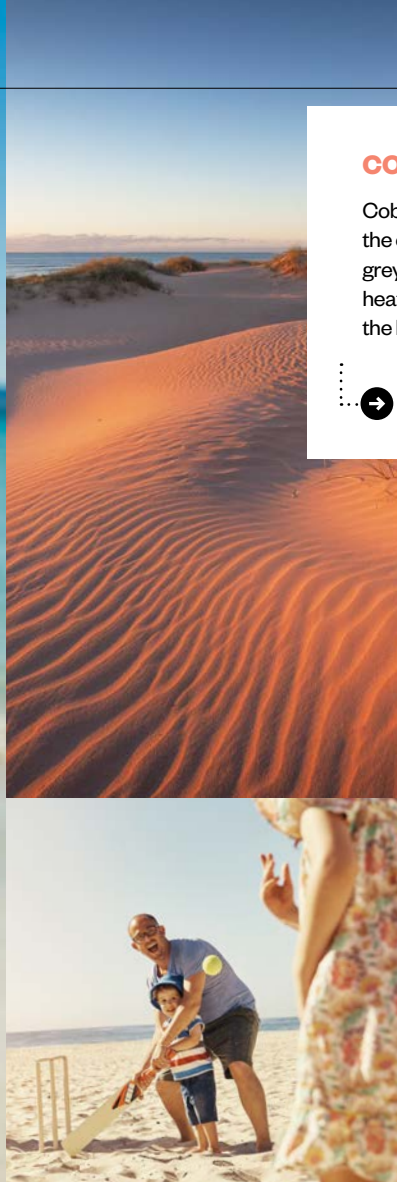

Des, the Rottnest Island tour guide, could not have put it better. When he saw a young girl marvelling at the incredible blues of the island's water, he asked her, "What colours do you see?"

"I see the colour of happiness, Des," she said.

Happiness is exactly what you will feel when you step off the ferry on to Rottnest Island. Known affectionately by locals as Rotto, the island is just 19 kilometres off the Perth coast and is home to some of the most spectacular beaches and bays in the world. In the Noongar language, the name of the Island is Wadjemup, which means 'place across the water where the spirits are,' and when you experience its otherworldly beauty, you will understand why.

A visit to the island is an unmissable day trip when visiting Perth. Here, you can meet the happiest animal on earth, the quokka, who really don't seem to mind posing for a selfie or two. Spend the day snorkelling, swimming, dining, relaxing and exploring this spectacular island.

Summer in Perth is hot and dry with very little rainfall. Average temperatures range from 17 to 30 degrees Celsius. In the afternoons, a sea breeze called the 'Fremantle Doctor' provides welcome relief from the heat.

Hot tips: Many people hire bikes to explore Rotto, but the island is large. You can book an air-conditioned bus tour that will take you around the entire island to some of the best photo spots with captivating commentary.

You can catch the ferry from Barrack Street in the city in the morning, spend the day on the island and be back in Perth in time for dinner! Pre-book the ferry and bus tour in advance. It books out fast, especially in summer and during school holidays.

**BRIGHTON BEACH
BATHING BOXES**



Melbourne comes alive in summer, welcoming its most famous event, The Australian Open, when the world's tennis greats touch down in the city. You need to book well in advance to get tickets to the men's and women's finals, but it is possible to pick up more affordable ground passes.

The summer months in Melbourne are December, January and February with temperatures ranging between 13 and 26 degrees Celsius, or sometimes spiking as high as 40 degrees.

On those Melbourne summer days, it's the perfect time to hit the water! A half hour away from Melbourne's CBD is beautiful Brighton Beach, famous for its 82 colourful bathing boxes that date back to the 1900s. Take a dip in the sparkling water to cool off, or simply stroll along the length of the beach while taking in the views.

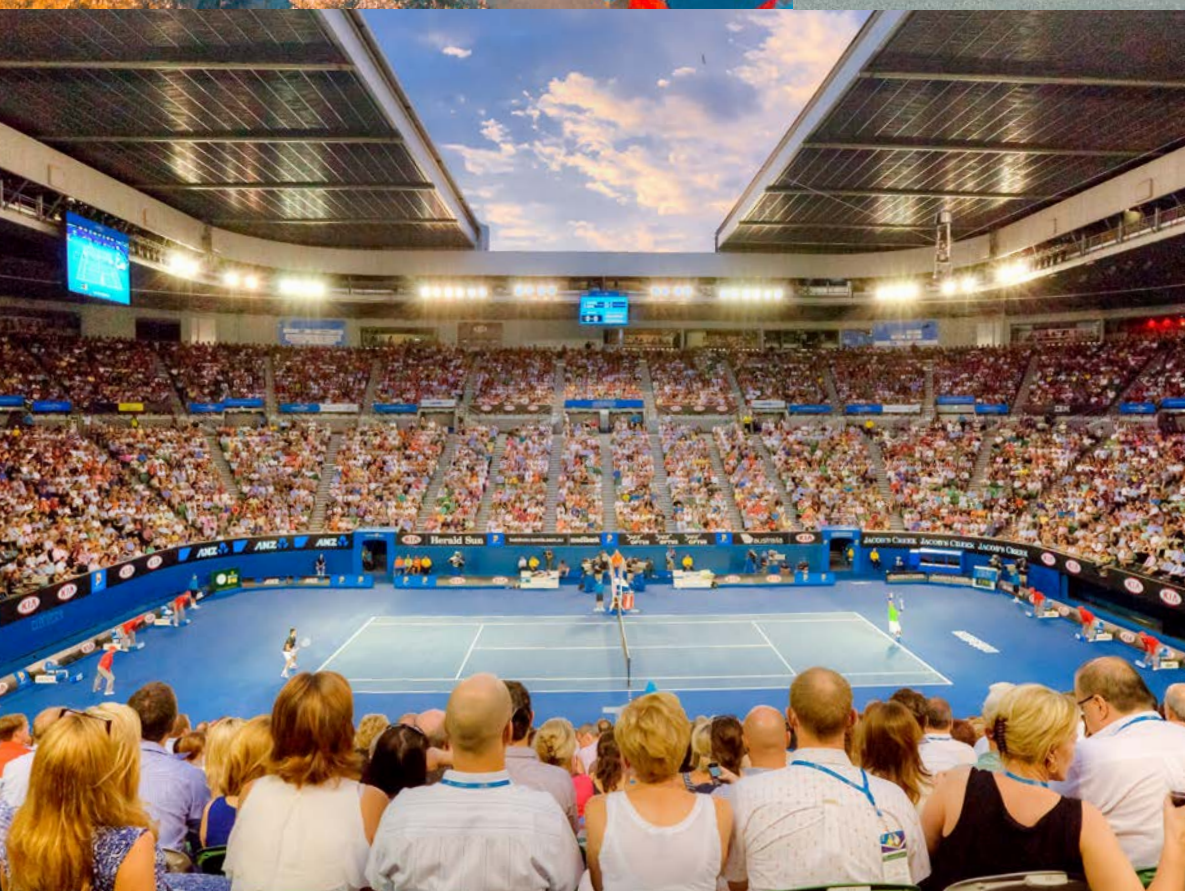

Joyful yellows of sunflowers, golden haybales polka dotting verdant green fields, the seashore filled with stripy beach umbrellas, bright displays of gelati and red chequered tablecloths. These are the colours of Tuscany, Italy! Summer in Tuscany brings warm nights and long daylight hours, meaning you have plenty of time to spend sightseeing.

No trip to Tuscany is complete without a visit to the Uffizi Gallery in Florence. It is one of the most acclaimed art galleries on Earth and houses an outstanding collection of sculptures and paintings that date from the middle ages to modern times. These include masterpieces by Giotto, Simone Martini, Filippo Lippi, Sandro Botticelli, Leonardo Da Vinci, Raffaello, Michelangelo and Caravaggio. It also boasts an incredible collection of ancient statues and busts from the Medici family. One of its most famous paintings is Botticelli's Birth of Venus, which depicts Venus born from the sea, standing on a clam shell, blown by the west wind, Zephyr, and the nymph, Chloris, who prepares to dress her with a flowered mantle.

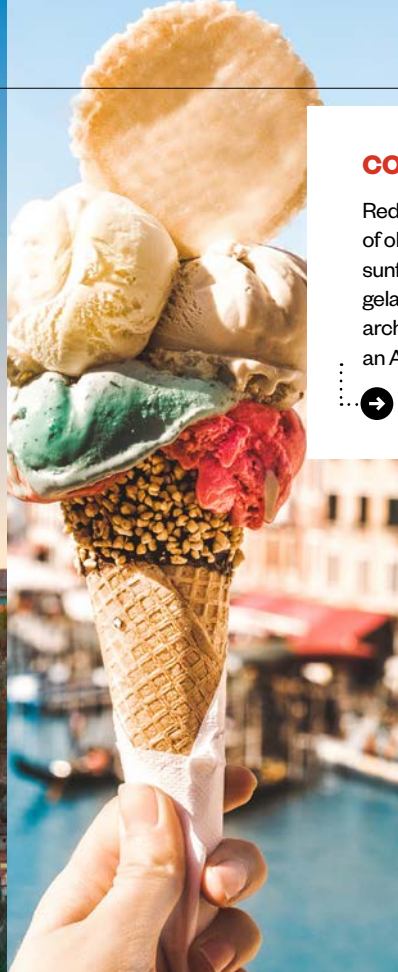

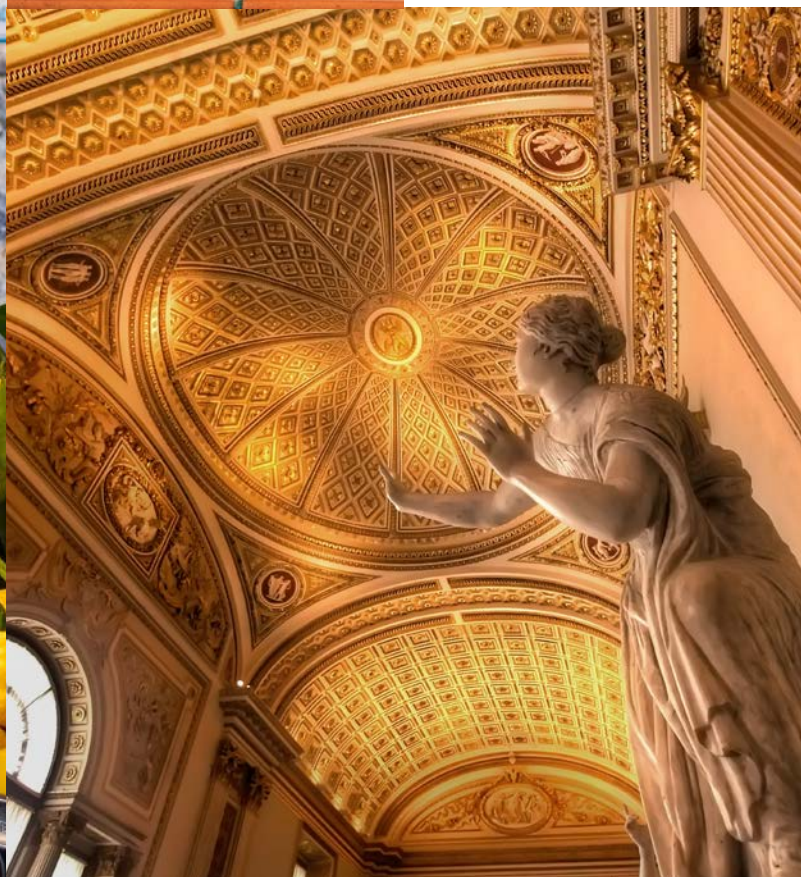

Summer is an incredible time to visit Wānaka. In the warmer months, this spectacular alpine region transforms from a world-famous snow destination to an adventure playground offering astonishing hiking, mountain biking and water sports. You can spend hours on the lake, kayaking, paddle boarding and boating, or just enjoy a swim at one of the many beach spots around the lake.

The summer season runs from the beginning of December to the end of February, with an average temperature of 24° Celsius. Long daylight hours mean the days usually don't end until well after 9pm, giving you plenty of time to explore.

A highlight is the lavender fields which bloom in the summer. Wanaka Lavender Farm is open from March to November but the best time to view the fields of lavender in bloom is from December to February. With over 7,000 plants across 12 hectares, it is a stunning sight to see. It is also home to friendly farm animals, making it the perfect place to stroll among the rows of flowers, unwind over a cup of herbal tea, sample local honey and indulge in a lavender ice cream!

COLOURS OF WANAKA:

White of snow-capped mountains, khaki and earthy tones of rugged alpine ranges, different shades of blue and green as Lake Wanaka reflects the sky, lavender and honey.

If you are a reader, you may be familiar with the bestseller written by M.L. Stedman, *The Light Between Oceans*. The story is an epic tale about love and isolation, set just after World War I in Western Australia. Cape Leeuwin was the inspiration for Stedman's book. As the tallest lighthouse on mainland Australia, it is a must-see when visiting the Margaret River region. It stands at the most south-westerly point of the country, at the tip of a spectacular peninsula, where the Southern and Indian Oceans meet.

Built in 1895, it is still a vital working lighthouse for vessels navigating the treacherous cape. The Interpretive Centre, housed within one of the original lightkeepers' cottages, is an impressive interactive experience that celebrates the history and lives of the many lighthouse keepers and their families, who have protected ships from the rugged coastline for over a century.

On your way down the coast from Club Wyndham Dunsborough, make time to stop at Hamelin Bay. This impossibly pretty beach with its turquoise water and sugar-white sand is famous for its friendly stingrays and eagle rays. You can stand in the water and pat them, or snorkel around the bay to see these remarkable creatures in their natural habitat.

Summer in the Margaret River region has little rainfall, and the average maximum temperature is just under 30 degrees Celsius.

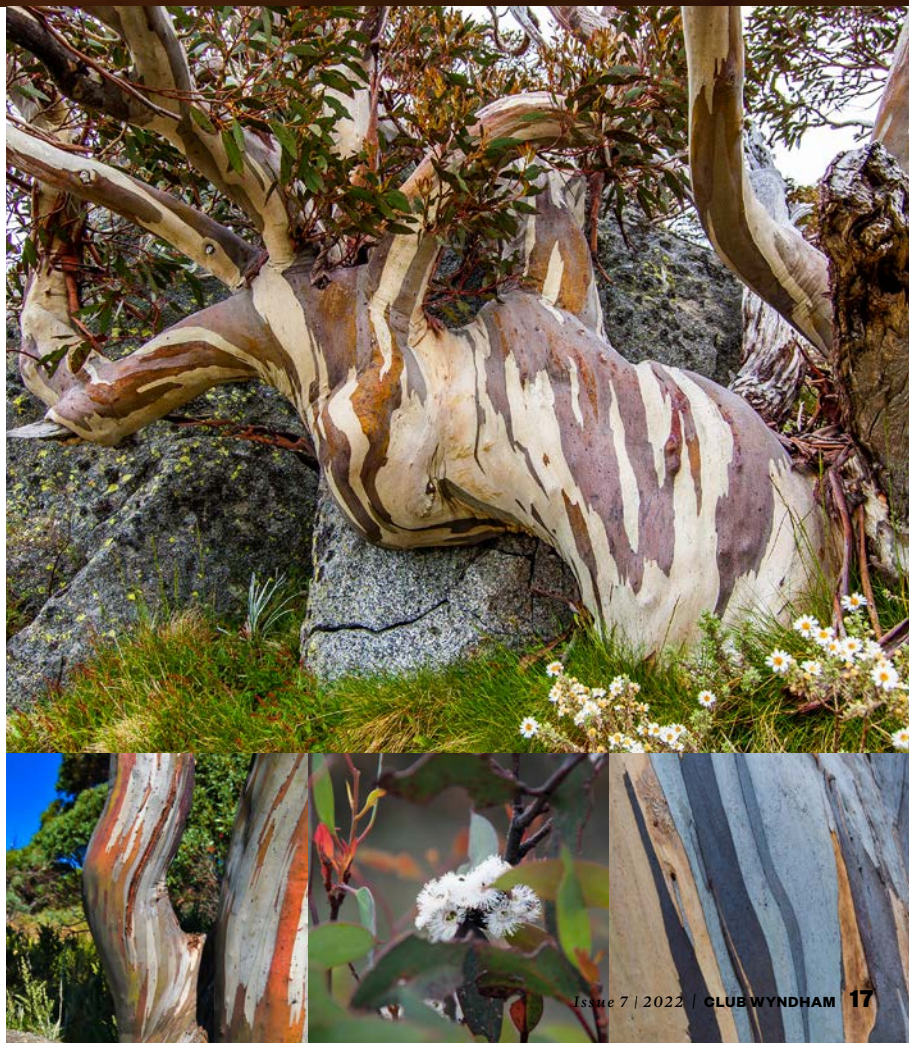

The twisted limbs seem to shimmer with colour. In summer, an abundance of white flowers bloom and with these majestic trees set among babbling brooks and sweeping scenery, it is little wonder the Australian Alps have been the subject of art, photography and poetry for centuries.

There is no place on earth like the Australian Alps and when you experience its unique beauty, you can expect to leave a little piece of your heart behind. When the snow melts to give way to summer, the Alpine National Park invites you to explore its scenic wonders.

At the heart of it all is the magnificent village of Dinner Plain, and your club resort with all the comforts to make your high-country experience truly special.

Dinner Plain's walking tracks lead to historic mountain huts, spring-fed waterfalls and sheer rockfaces. From epic treks to easy strolls, there is an experience for everyone. Be sure to speak to the team at reception to find out how to register your hike, pick up trail maps and gather tips for hiking safely in the high-country.

NORMANDY

Inspired by the beauty of the

region, artist Claude Monet called Normandy home. The famous water lilies of Monet's garden and the green painted shutters of his home have inspired travellers for close to a century. Visiting his garden, like many other parts of Normandy, feels like stepping into an impressionist masterpiece. In summer, the region's extra-long daylight hours give you plenty of opportunities to explore. While Mont-Saint Michel is an unmissable sight to see, be sure to also visit the pretty harbour town of Honfleur to marvel at its 15th and 16th-century buildings which encircle a pretty yacht filled harbour. The town is famous for serving up some of the best 'moule frites' in the country, a steaming hot bowl of fresh mussels cooked in white wine and served with French fries. Wash it down with a locally crafted cider and you will be living life like a true Norman.

THEY SAY THAT A PICTURE PAINTS

A THOUSAND WORDS,

however, there are just not enough words to articulate the breathtaking beauty of Canada and Alaska. I had the absolute pleasure of travelling to this stunning corner of the world this past June and wow, what a great land to behold!

Descending into Vancouver, the snow hooded mountains are encased by a spectacular necklace of pure white snow. The majestic alps parade this land and provide an uplifting sense of elation, particularly after a 15-hour flight when the withers of jetlag begin to set in. I was fortunate to travel with nine great industry folk from all corners of Australia, accompanied by three representatives from APT & Holland America Cruiselines.

Once we had cleared a relatively easy customs process, we set off bound for Whistler, the home of the 2010 Winter Olympics. The drive along the Sea to Sky Highway was simply awe inspiring, meandering along the edge of "Howe Sound", an Ocean Fjord with snowy peaks and glistening turquoise waters. We passed through the adventure capital town of Squamish, famous for its outdoor activities and home to the Squamish indigenous folk of this region. I later learnt more about this impressive culture when we stopped by the Squamish Lil'wat Cultural Centre in Whistler, which houses many extraordinary creations and stories of a culture that continues to thrive.

There are so many pretty spots to stop off along this laneway to the east including waterfalls, picnic locations, museums and viewpoints.

We soon arrive in the cosy village of Whistler where we spend the next two days frolicking in this scenic playground.

From zip lining across the chequered pine plantations and icy rivers to the impressive tracks of a Jeep exploration in the heights above the village, where we encounter several bear families in their natural surrounds, this friendly winter village has a spiritual ambience that will warm the cockles of your heart in any season.

Before we know it, we are back in Vancouver preparing for our cruise to Alaska with Holland America Line. Our accommodation is just opposite the port at Canada Place and lucky for us they offer pre-cruise PCR testing.

With anxious bated breath, we are all cleared for boarding. This is really happening!

We are cruising on MS Koningsdam, which dazzles with nautical tradition at every turn. Built in 2016, she is a Pinnacle Class ship and comfortable from every corner for our journey to The Great Land of Alaska, also known as Alyeska.

Interestingly, I learn from onboard presentations that Russia sold Alaska to the USA back in 1867 for 39 cents per acre. What a bargain for such pristine land.

I also learn that there is one bear to every 23 people in these lands, and more than 130 volcanoes, of which 90 have been active in the past 10,000 years.

Our first port of call, Juneau, surprisingly is the second largest city by area in the USA. One interesting fact about it is that the town can only be accessed by sea or air. The closest highway is some 100km to the east by foot.

My excitement was on overdrive at this point, as for years I have been recommending musher dog camps and dog sledding to travelers, and now I was preparing to experience this for myself.

Dog mushing is the most popular sport in Alaska and the annual Iditarod race is the main event. This great race also comes with some history. The race came about when a large diphtheria epidemic threatened the northern village of Nome back in 1925. Antitoxin was desperately needed but could only be sourced some 1,000 miles away in Anchorage. Planes could not be used and ships were too slow, so they sent a pack of 100 dogs in relays north to Nome. They ran the longest distance of any team and reached Nome in five and a half days. The dogs saved the town and earned their mark in history. These beautiful Alaskan Huskies continue this tradition every year. They have piercing blue eyes and attitudes to boot. Most trainers relocate their packs from the lower 48 during the summer months to continue their training regimes in these summer camps. These incredibly athletic dogs are genetically engineered with the aptitude to develop strength, endurance, intelligence and tolerance for extreme weather.

They are even bred to develop more fur in the gaps of their paws to protect against the elements.

We witness the Huskies howl with excitement as we circle and swirl from left to right. These incredible creatures live for this sport and their trainers are just as committed. After our ride, we are greeted with a big surprise – cuddles with gorgeous puppies who are the future runners of this race. This was truly an incredible experience.



Our next stop, Skagway has us now situated on the fringe of the glaciers. The people are friendly. The old time saloons are overflowing with enthusiasm and the landscapes are vast. Waterfalls can be seen trickling from crevices in the mountains and the tundra is soggy from the recently melted snow. We travel through the scenic White Pass and Yukon railway, yet another remarkable spectacle that showcases the stunning scenery of these lands.

The next day has me up and out on the deck at 5.30am. The icy air stings my cheeks as we enter the famous Glacier Bay. Cheeky otters can be seen backstroking beside the ship. Birdlife is abundant and whale spouts can be seen on the watery horizons. These fjords and national park are simply jaw dropping.

From the striking colours of the ice leading to the water's edge and trickling into the glacier laden ocean, to the perfectly formed snow white peaks with the swirls of low lying clouds, to the immense scale of the ice cliffs as they rumble and carve into the sea – everything is so grand in this part of the world.

wave that almost sunk this now fully restored vessel. This experience was unique, interesting and very well presented. The King Crab with hot butter was also hard to beat for lunch!

I've spent many an hour these past 28 years crafting Canada and Alaska itineraries for eager Aussie travellers. I've researched these mighty lands to the core, but never did I envisage such raw alpine and glacial beauty. It is truly an area of the world that is so untouched. The people are friendly and the lands are in a pure existence of vibrancy. If this destination is on your bucket list, don't wait until tomorrow - this beautiful land is open and ready to capture your heart.

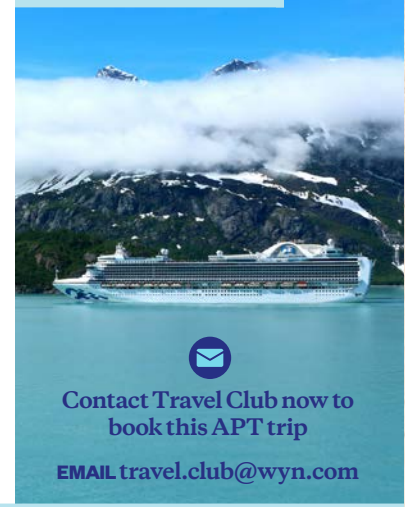

This experience gave me an unexpected opportunity to handle creatures from the Bering Sea and hear stories from the treacherous rogue

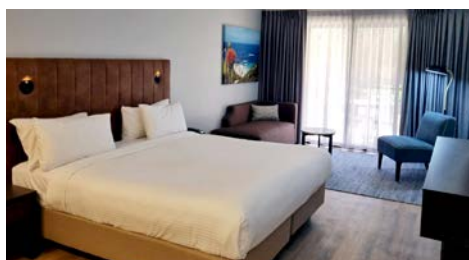
Club Wyndham Dunsborough

In standard apartments, kitchen benchtops are being replaced and cabinets refaced, while luxury vinyl flooring will be laid in the living areas and 100 per cent wool carpet in the bedroom areas.



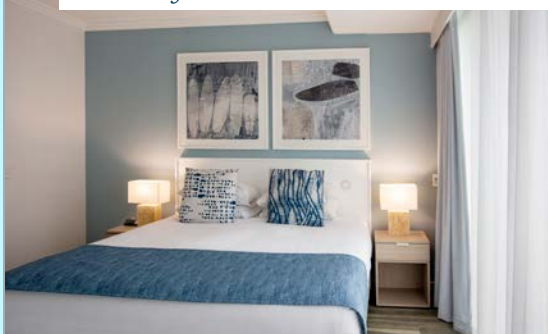

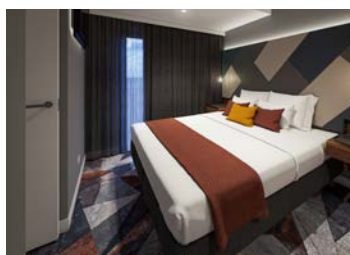

There are many other vessels which visit this wonderful beach and also a seaplane which lands and takes off on the water close to the shore. Its passengers enjoy a very unique experience.

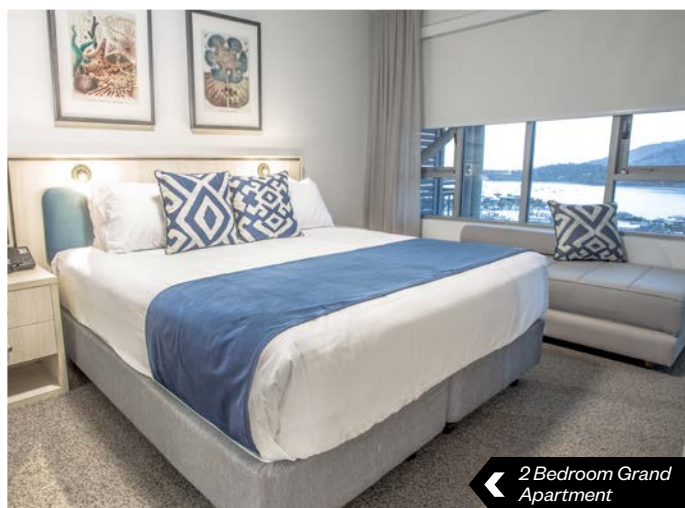

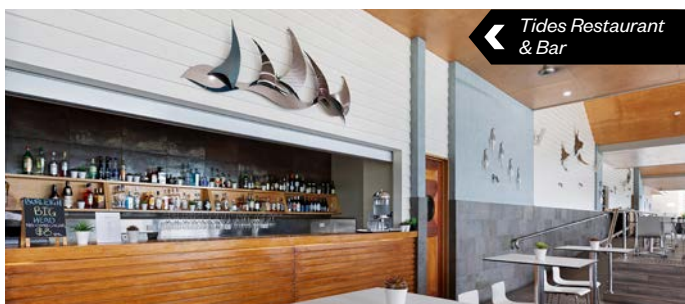
The cruise includes a glass of bubbles and a cheese and dips platter. There is also a bar on board.

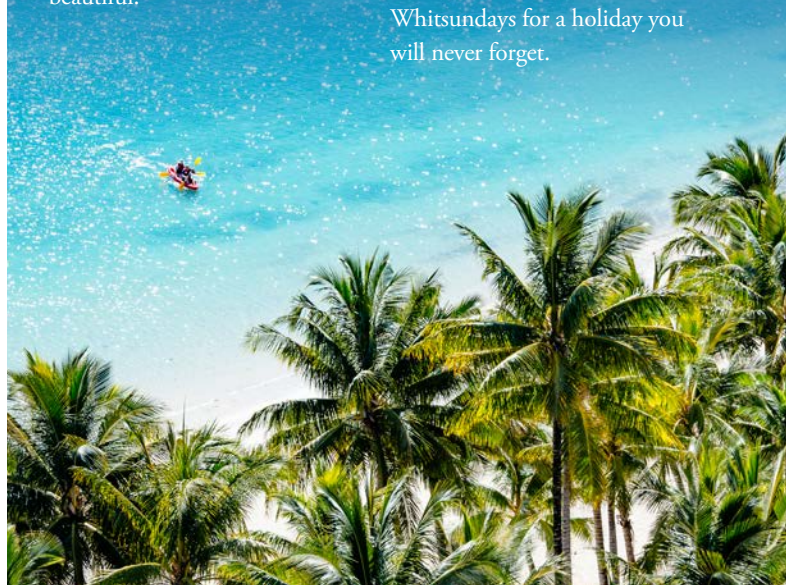
Tides Restaurant

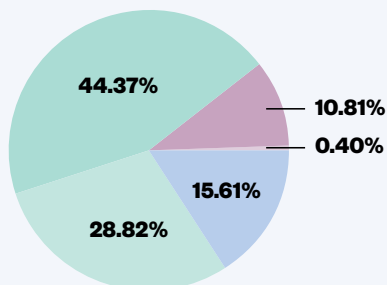

Club Wyndham South Pacific's inventory in Japan is structured in a different way. The club owns points within Sundance Resort Club, which enables owners to access Sundance's 16 resorts and apartments. The balance of the Sundance Resort Club points are owned by the club's own members and other timeshare clubs managed by Wyndham Destinations Asia Pacific.



The arrangement enables Club Wyndham South Pacific owners to utilise a broader range of room types (subject to availability) for a lesser financial commitment to the club than if the inventory was purchased directly. Bookings at some resorts need to be made through Owner Services.

This inventory is displayed separately as Japanese apartments do not traditionally conform to one, two or three-bedroom formats, but are large rooms with multiple beds. Some apartments offer raised Western-style bedding, while others offer futon-style bedding that is customary in Japan.
